

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS

BY-LAW # 33-2006

Being a By-Law relating to the Use, Protection and Regulation of Public Parks and Recreation Areas under the jurisdiction of The Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards.

WHEREAS Section 130 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, as amended, authorizes Councils of local municipalities to regulate matters related to the health, safety and well being of inhabitants of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1.0 Title:

- 1.1 This bylaw shall be known as the "Camping in Parks By-Law".

2.0 Definitions:

2.1 In this By-Law:

- (a) **"Corporation"** or **"Township"** means the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards.
- (b) **"Enforcement Officer"** means any police officer, provincial offences officer or employee of the township whose duties include the enforcement of this by-law.
- (c) **"Park"** includes any land owned, leased or controlled by the Municipality, designated or used as a park, playground, sport field, trail or public open space.
- (d) **"Post"** or **"Posted Area"** means the erection or presence of permissive, regulatory, restrictive, warning or prohibitive signs and "posted area" means an area where signs are erected.

3.0 Camping:

- 3.1 Camping is prohibited in a park, or in a structure in a park, unless otherwise posted or by permission of the Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards or designated employee.

4.0 Posting of Signs:

- 4.1 The Municipality may post signs of permission, regulation, restriction, warning or prohibition with respect to uses of or activities in any park in accordance with the provisions hereof.

5.0 Enforcement:

- 5.1 Any police officer, municipal law enforcement officer or employee of the municipality whose duties include the enforcement of this by-law is authorized to request any person believed by such officer or employee to be contravening or who has contravened any provision of this by-law:
- (a) to desist from the activity constituting or contributing to such contravention.
 - (b) to remove from the park anything owned by or in the control of such person which the officer or employee believes is or was involved in such contravention; and/or
 - (c) to leave the park.
- 5.2 Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to pay a penalty recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.
- 5.3 Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is subject to the Trespass to Property Act of Ontario being enforced.

6.0 **Effective Date:**

6.1 This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of passing.
