

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS

BY-LAW NUMBER 47-2016

Being a by-law to establish and assume a highway into the municipal road system.

WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 c.25 permits a lower-tier municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS under Sections 31 of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c. 25 the Council of a municipality may establish highways by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards deems it necessary to establish and assume a highway it into the municipal road system;

AND WHEREAS the highway municipally known as Foy Park Corridor, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, has been constructed in accordance with the agreement between the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards and Malcolm Foy & Corey Foy in partnership carrying on a business as M. Foy & Sons;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. THAT the highway municipally known as Foy Park Corridor is hereby established and assumed into the municipal road system.
2. THAT this by-law shall come into effect upon the third and final reading thereof.
