Public Meeting

The Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with Councillors Isabel O'Reilly, Ernie Cybulski, Stanley Pecoskie, Debbie Peplinskie and Carl Kuehl present. Mayor Janice Visneskie chaired the meeting, which she opened and called to order.

Pecuniary/Financial Interest: No pecuniary\financial interest was declared by any of the Council members present.

Purpose of Meeting: Mayor Visneskie explained that the purpose of the meeting is to discuss By-Law #36-2010, being a by-law to zone certain lands located in Part of Lot 13, Concession 9, Geographic Township of Hagarty, to Provincially Significant Wetland (PSW), to Provincially Significant Wetland-Exception One (PSW-E1) and to Rural-Exception Six (RU-E6).

The CAO/Clerk-Treasurer advised that all necessary notices have been complied with.

No delegations were present, and no written presentations had been received.

Mayor Visneskie opened the floor for discussion. No members of the public were present. Mayor Visneskie stated the following:

Section 34(11) of the Planning Act – If Council decides to refuse an application or refuses or neglects to make a decision on an application within 120 days of the municipal clerk receiving an application, the applicant or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing an appeal with the clerk of the municipality.”

“Section 34(19) – Not later than 20 days after the giving of notice of passing of the by-law, the applicant, any person or public body who made oral submissions at the public meeting or made a written submission to Council, before the by-law was passed, or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing an appeal with the clerk of the municipality.”
